Excellencies,

I wish to formally extend an invitation to all Members of the Peacebuilding Commission (PBC) to participate in the first Annual Session of the Peacebuilding Commission, scheduled for Monday, 23 June 2014. The opening and closing segments of the session will take place at 10:00 AM and 5:00 PM, respectively, in the Trusteeship Council Chamber. I am pleased to inform that the UN Secretary-General has agreed to address the opening segment. The Presidents of the General Assembly and the Security Council have been invited to participate and address the closing segment. I am currently in contact with a potential keynote speaker who will be invited to address the opening segment.

Following-up on the decision taken on 3 December 2013 by the PBC's Organizational Committee to convene an annual session around the date of the observance of "Peacebuilding Day" (see annex to A/68/729 - S/2014/67 for the agreed modalities), and following-up on a series of consultations within the Committee, Member States have agreed that the theme of the Annual Session in 2014 would be "Sustainable support for peacebuilding: the domestic and international aspects". The opening segment is designed to place the theme in the broader strategic context of the multidimensional nature of peacebuilding.

Two interactive working sessions will address related sub-themes and will take place between the opening and closing segments. The discussions in the interactive sessions will aim at further elaborating where inter-governmental policy and political support can improve outcomes for people in countries emerging from conflict. An appraisal of the discussions at the interactive working sessions will be

presented at the closing segment.
