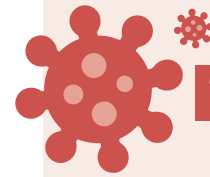

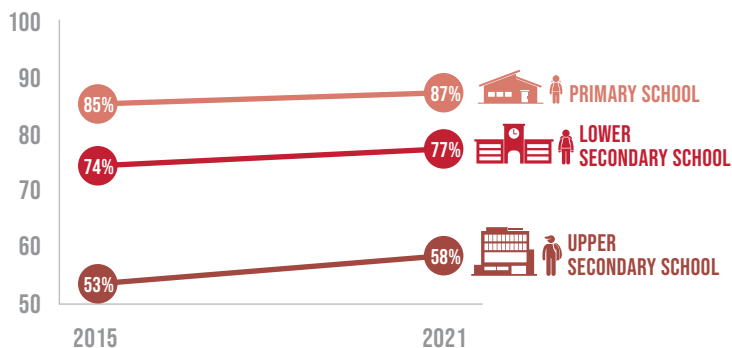


THE PANDEMIC
