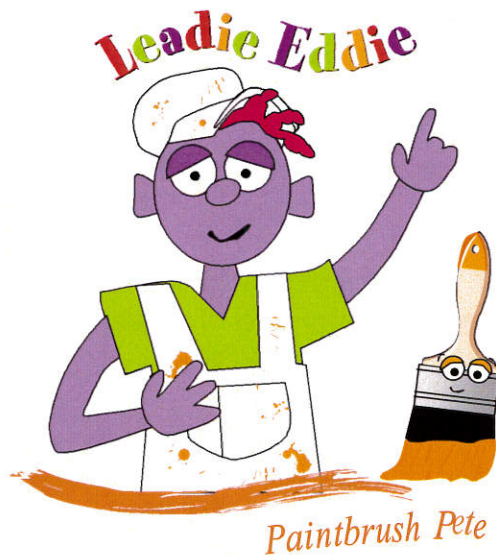

# Did you know?

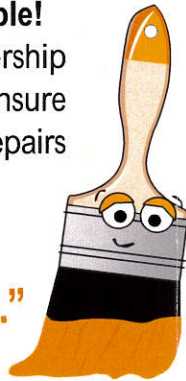
Lead poisoning can cause permanent brain damage in young children. It is also one of the top three preventable causes of mental retardation. Lead poisoning is 100% preventable.

Lead-based paint is the primary source of lead poisoning of children in Iowa. Two-thirds of our community's housing stock was built before 1978 (when lead based paint was banned).

In some of our neighborhoods, the rate of children who are tested for lead poisoning with elevated blood lead levels is 3 to 8 times greater than the national lead poisoning rate.

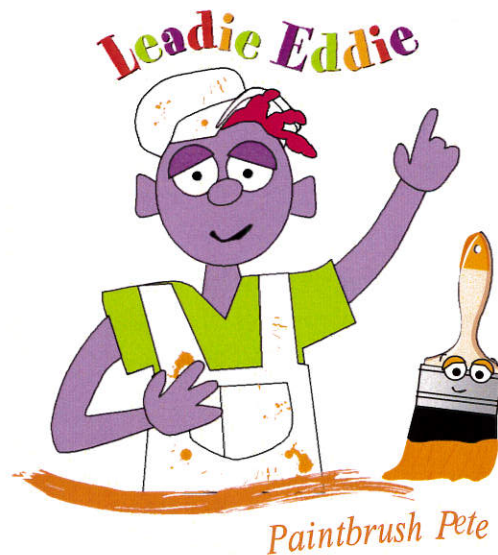

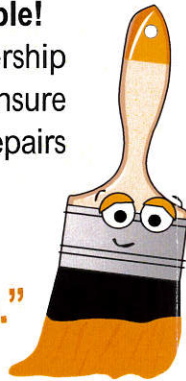
