Notice of Early Voting

Early voting will take place at the Madison County Agriculture Complex Auditorium located at 309 N. Parkway, Jackson, TN. Early voting hours will be from 9:00 am -4 pm on weekdays and from 9:00 am until 12:00 noon on Saturdays.

ABSENTEE VOTING

Voters in certain categories may vote by mail by requesting absentee ballots at least (7) days before the election. Common categories include voters who will be out of the county, college students in school outside the county, voters with physical disabilities, and voters who are over 60 or older. July 25 is the last day to receive a request for an absentee ballot.
