CALL (850) 942-8833, EXT 9 OR CONTACT US ON SOCIAL MEDIA IF YOU SEE:

- Tornadoes, Waterspouts, Funnel Clouds, or Wall Clouds
- ❖ Damaging winds; "severe" level wind = 58mph or higher
- ❖ Hail 1" in diameter (quarter sized) or larger and any associated damage
- Flash Flooding Is water flowing over roads or threatening life and property?
- Any damage that may be weather related, even after the event has ended

WHAT TO INCLUDE IN YOUR REPORT

- ❖ WHO you are your name and that you're a SKYWARN spotter
- ❖ WHAT type of event Be as detailed as possible and include pictures if you can
- ❖ WHERE you are Your location and the location of the event
- ❖ WHEN did the event occur The start & end time or provide real time updates

IMPORTANT REFERENCE MATERIAL

30 - 40 MPH	Whole trees in motion
40 - 50 MPH	Twigs or small branches breaking
50 - 60 MPH	Slight structural damage; Healthy branches breaking
60 – 70+ MPH	Down or snapped trees; Structural damage

0.70"	Dime
0.75"	Penny
0.88"	Nickel
1.00"	Quarter
1.25"	Half Dollar
1.50"	Ping Pong Ball
1.75"	Golf Ball
2.00"	Hen Egg or Lime

2.75"	Baseball
3.00"	Large Apple or Teacup
4.00"	Softball
5" or more	Probably some sort of record, freeze it and call the NWS!
