

**BUY AMERICA, BUILD AMERICA (BABA) SELF-CERTIFICATION**

\_\_\_\_\_ (project owner name, hereinafter known as “Project Owner”) must comply with the requirements of the Build America, Buy America Act (BABA), 41 USC 8301 note, and all applicable rule and notices, as may be amended. Pursuant to HUD’s Notice, “Public Interest Phased Implementation Waiver for FY 2022 and 2023 of Build America, Buy America Provision as Applied to recipients of HUD Federal Financial Assistance” (88 FR 17001), any funds obligated by HUD on or after the applicable listed effective dates, are subject to BABA requirements, unless excepted by a waiver.

The Build America, Buy America Act (BABA) requires that all iron, steel, manufactured products, and construction materials used for federally funded infrastructure projects are produced in the United States, unless otherwise exempt or subject to an approved waiver. Please see the West Virginia Housing Development Build America, Buy America Policy for more information.

For HOME- and HTF-funded projects subject to BABA, the **contractor, subcontractors, and lower-tier subcontractors will submit Project Materials Exhibit A and certify**, to the best of his/her knowledge and belief (check one):

All iron, steel, manufactured products, and construction materials used in in the project **were produced in the United States.**

Some or all iron, steel, manufactured products, and construction materials used in in the project **were not produced in the United States.**

Types of iron, steel, manufactured product, or construction materials are not produced in the United States in sufficient and reasonably available quantities or of a satisfactory quality.

For HOME- and HTF-funded projects subject to BABA, the Project Owner certifies to the best of his/her knowledge and belief:

(yes or no) The inclusion of domestically produced iron, steel, manufactured products, and construction materials will increase the cost of the **total project cost** by more than 25%.

Furthermore, the Project Owner certifies, to the best of his/her knowledge and belief certifies:

1. The cost of the components of the manufactured product that are mined, produced, or manufactured in the United States is greater than 55% of the total cost of all components of the manufactured product, unless another standard for determining the minimum amount of domestic content of the manufactured product has been established under applicable law or regulation.
2. All construction materials are manufactured in the United States. This means that all manufacturing processes for the construction material occurred in the United States.

The Project Owner certifies or affirms the truthfulness and accuracy of each statement of this certification.
