### 1) Kakau ma ka pūnaewelege

Aia ka 'ōnaehana pūnaewelege Kāinoai Koho Paloka o ka 'Oihana Koho Pāloka Moku'āina 'o Hawai'i ma ke kaha pūnaewelege o ka 'Oihana Koho Pāloka. [Loulou Kāinoai Koho Pāloka](#)

He laikini kalaiwa ka'a Moku'āina 'o Hawai'i 'oia'i'o o kēia au a i 'ole he palapala kuhikuhi kanaka Moku'āina 'o Hawai'i kekahi koina no ke kāinoai 'ana ma ka 'ōnaehana pūnaewelege kāinoai koho pāloka. Pa'a nā lā palena pau no ke kāinoai koho pāloka a me ke noi koho pāloka kahi 'ē.

### 2) E Ho'oili i Palapala Kāinoai

## Ke'ena o ke Kākau 'Ōlelo Kūlanakauhale

E ho'ouna 'ia nō ka pāloka i ka po'e koho pāloka a pau, i kāinoa pono ma mua o ka lā palena pau.

### E Koho Pāloka Leka

E ho'ouna 'ia ka pū'olo pāloka i ka po'e koho pāloka me kēia mau mea i loko:

- He pāloka;
- He wahī hūnā (melemele);
- He wahī ho'iho'i pāloka; a
- Nā kuhikuhina like 'ole no ke koho pāloka

### Ke Ka'ina Hana no ke Koho Pāloka

1. Leka E heluhelu i nā 'ao'ao 'elua o ka/nā pāloka a me nā kuhikuhina a pau i ho'okomo pū 'ia. Mark your choices on a separate paper first.
2. No ke koho 'ana, e ho'opouli pono i ka hakahaka ma kahi o kāu koho me ka peni 'īnika 'ele'ele a uliuli paha.
3. E ho'okomo i ka pāloka i ho'opiha 'ia ma loko o ka wahī leka hūnā melemele a e pani i ka wahī.
4. E ho'okomo i ka wahī hūnā melemele ma loko o ka Wahī Leka Ho'iho'i Pāloka (he ho'iho'i 'oihana). Inā noi 'ia 'oe e ho'ouna i nā kope o ka palapala kuhikuhi kanaka me kāu pāloka koho, e ho'okomo nō i nā palapala. E pani i ka wah a pa'a.
5. E PŪLIMA 'oe i ka 'ōlelo hō'opia ma ka Wahī Ho'iho'i Pāloka. 'A'OLE e helu 'ia kāu pāloka inā pūlima 'ole 'ia ka 'ōlelo hō'opia.

6. E ho'ouna koke 'oe i ka wahī i loa'a mai iā mākou ma mua o ka hola 7:00 p.m. ma ka Lā Koho. Ma ke kānāwai Moku'āina, 'a'ole e helu 'ia nā pāloka leka i loa'a mai ma hope o ka hola 7:00 p.m. ma ka Lā Koho.

### Nā Pāloka Leka Hewa

'A'ole e hiki ke 'alo a'e i nā kaha hewa. E 'olu'olu, 'a'ole e kau i ka leki a wai ho'oponopono ke'oke'o ma ka pāloka no ka ho'oponopono 'ana i nā hewa, pēlā nō i nā kahakaha ho'oponopono. Inā kaha hewa 'oe ma ka pāloka, e kāhea i ke ke'ena no ka pāloka hou. Aia nō i ka pō'aiapili (ka manawa, apa..), e a'oa'o ka po'e hana o ke ke'ena iā 'oe no kāu ala kūpono e koho pāloka ai. Eia na'e, i loko nō o ka manawa a me ka pō'aiapili, 'o kekahī hopena paha kou hele kino 'ana e ki'i i pāloka hou, a i 'ole e koho ma kekahī Hale Lawelawe Koho Pāloka.

### Koho Pāloka Kahi 'Ē ('oiai a'ole ma kahi noho)

Ka Palapala Noi Koho "Ho'okahi Kau" – E ho'opiha i kēia palapala noi inā aia ana 'oe ma kahi 'ē ma ke kau koho pāloka.. E ho'ouna 'ia kāu pāloka i ka helu wahi kūikawā āu i waiho ai Loulou Palapala Noi "Ho'okahi Kau"

### Nā Hale Lawelawe Koho Pāloka

No ke anahulu (he 10 mau lā hana) ma mua o ka lā koho a ma ia lā nō, hiki ke koho pāloka ma kekahī Hale Lawelawe Koho Pāloka. Ma ia anahulu, hiki i ka po'e i kāinoa 'ole ke kāinoa a koho pāloka. E nānā i ka papa Hale Lawelawe Koho Pāloka a me nā lā hemo i pāku'i 'ia. **'A'ole e mālama 'ia nā wahi koho pāloka hele kino ma'amau e like me nā Lā Koho ma mua.**

Hiki i ka po'e koho pāloka a pau i kāinoa 'ia ma ke Kūlanakauhale a Kalana 'o Honolulu ke koho pāloka ma kekahī o nā wahi, me ka nānā 'ole i ko lākou māhele 'āina.



No ka holo pono 'ana o ke ka'ina hana koho pāloka, e 'olu'olu e lawe mai i kāu palapala kuhikuhi kanaka i ka Hale Lawelawe Koho Pāloka.

Eia nā palapala kuhikuhi kanaka i 'ae 'ia:

- Laikini kalaiwa ka'a Moku'āina;
- Kāleka kuhikuhi kanaka Moku'āina;
- Kāleka kuhikuhi kanaka Pū'ali Koa 'Amelika;
- Palapala 'Ae Holo 'oia'i'o; a i 'ole
- He palapala kāki mikaō, he hō'ike panakō, he pila kīko'o aupuni, he palapala aupuni, a he pila kīko'u uku o kēia au e hō'ike 'ia ana kou inoa a me kou wahi noho.

Ma kou hō'ea 'ana mai i kahi Hale Lawelawe Koho Pāloka, e noi paha 'ia 'oe e ho'opiha i palapala kāinoa hou inā pono.

Inā 'a'ohe ou palapala kuhikuhi kanaka kūpono, e noi 'ia 'oe no kekahi mau 'ikepili no ka hō'opia 'ana i kou inoa. He mea ho'olilo manawa kēia hana.

### Nā Wahi Ho'okomo

Hiki ke waiho 'ia nā pāloka ma nā pahu ho'okomo mai ka lā 'umikūmāwalu ma mua o ka La Koho a hiki i ka hola 7:00 p.m. o ka Lā Koho. E nānā i ka papa Wahi Ho'okomo a me nā lā hemo i pāku'i 'ia.

### Ka Paipai Kālai'āina

Ma ke kānāwai 'o Hawaii Revised Statute §11-132, ma loko o ka 'ili 'āina he 'elua haneli kapua'i mai ke anapuni o kekahi hale lawelawe koho pāloka, kekahi wahi ho'okomo pāloka, a me nā wahi pili koho pāloka 'ē a'e, pāpā 'ia ka hō'ike a me ka ho'olaha 'ana i nā ki'i paipai kālai'āina, nā hō'ailona, a kekahi mea paipai kālai'āina 'ē a'e paha me ka mana'o e loa'a nā koho no ke kāko'o a kū'ē paha i kekahi kanaka a 'ao'ao kālai'āina paha, a i 'ole kekahi pane no nā nīnau pāloka.

### Ke Komo Ma'alahi o ka Po'e Koho

Ma'alahi ke komo 'ana ma nā Hale Lawelawe Koho Pāloka no ka po'e kīnānā, inā paha he kīnānā pilikino a i 'ole he kīnānā 'ē a'e. Ho'ohana 'ia nā hāme'a koho ma nā Hale Lawelawe Koho Pāloka i hiki i ka po'e kīnānā ke koho kā'oko'a. ## Nā Hō‘ike & Nā Ho‘ōki Koho Pāloka

### Nā Hō‘ike no ka Po‘e Koho Pāloka

Inā kāinoa pono ‘oe e koho pāloka, e ho‘ouna ‘ia he kāleka melemele Hō‘ike Kūlana Koho Pāloka iā ‘oe ma ‘Apelila o ka makahiki koho. Ho‘ouna pū ‘ia ia kāleka ma kekahi mau wā o ka makahiki koho i ka po‘e i kāinoa iho nei a i ka po‘e kāinoa hou.

### Ho‘ōki Koho Pāloka

Ke mana‘o ‘oe e hō‘ole i i ke koho pāloka ‘ana, hiki iā ‘oe ke kāpae i kou kūlana koho pāloka. Hiki pū ke kāpae i ke kūlana koho pāloka o ka ‘ohana i hala akula. ### NĀNAU PINEPINE – Ka Ho‘ihoi ‘ana i ka Pāloka Koho

**Āheia ka wā palena pau e ho‘ihoi ‘ia ai ka‘u pāloka koho?**

Ma ke Kānāwai Moku‘āina, pono e loa‘a nā pāloka koho ma mua o ka hola 7:00 p.m. (kā‘ei hola Hawai‘i) ma ka Lā Koho no ka helu ‘ia ‘ana.

**He aha kekahi mau ala e ho‘ihoi ‘ia ai ka‘u pāloka leka?**

Hiki ke waiho i kāu pāloka koho ma kekahi o nā Hale Lawelawe Koho Pāloka a i ‘ole ma kekahi Wahi Ho‘okomo, eia nō na‘e ho‘i ‘o ka loa‘a nō ia ma mua o ka wā palena pau i hō‘ike ‘ia ma luna a‘e.

**Pehea e ho‘oponopono ‘ia ai kekahi kaha hewa ma ka‘u pāloka a wahī ho‘ihoi paha?**

E kūka‘i ‘oe me ko mākou ke‘ena ma 808-768-3800 no ka ‘ōlelo a‘o.

### NĀNAU PINEPINE - Ke Kāinoia Koho Pāloka ‘ana

**Pono au e kāinoia no ke koho pāloka ‘ana?**

Ae. Koi ‘ia ke kāinoia koho pāloka ‘ana no ka po‘e koho hou loa.

**Koi ‘ia anei ke kāinoia hou ‘ana no ke koho pāloka?**

Ke ho‘ololi ‘oe i kou inoa a lolii kou helu wahi noho a leka paha, koi ‘ia ke kāinoia hou ‘ana.

**Āheia ka lā palena pau e kāinoia ai no ke koho pāloka?**

Hiki ke kāinoia no ke koho pāloka a hiki i ka lā 10 ma mua o ka lā koho. Pono e loa‘a a i ‘ole kuni ‘ia ka palapala kāinoia koho pāloka ma mua o ka lā palena pau.

**He aha nā koina e kāinoia ai no ke koho pāloka?**

He Kupa ‘Amelika, he kanaka noho pa‘a ma Hawai‘i, a piha he 16 a ‘oi mau makahiki (no ke kāinoia hiki mua) nā koina o ka po‘e kāinoia.

**Pehea e hō‘oia ai i ko‘u kūlana koho pāloka?**

Ho‘ouna ‘ia ka Hō‘ike Kūlana Koho Pāloka a me ka Hō‘oia Wahi Noho (kāleka melemele) ma ‘Apelila o ka makahiki koho. Ua kāinoia pono ‘oe no ke koho pāloka inā loa‘a kēia kāleka iā ‘oe. Hiki pū ke kelepona i ka Māhele Koho Pāloka ma 808-768-3800 no ka hō‘oia ana.

**He koina ka helu wahi noho no ke kāinoia koho pāloka? Pehea lā inā ‘a‘ohe ou helu wahi ma‘amau?**

Inā ‘a‘ohe ou helu wahi noho, he koina ka wehewehe kūpono ‘ana i kou wahi e noho ai. Pēlā nō e ho‘oholo ia ai kou ‘āpana koho kūpono e nā luna koho.

**Hiki anei ke koho pāloka inā ‘āhewa ‘ia au no kekahi peloni?**

Inā ho‘opa‘ahao ‘ia kekahi kanaka koho no ka peloni, a‘ole hiki iā ia ke koho pāloka mai ka wā o ka ‘ōlelo ho‘opa‘i a hiki i kona ho‘oku‘u loa ‘ana. Eia na‘e, inā ho‘oku‘u kūikawā ‘ia ke kanaka ma ka wā ho‘omalu a i ole ma ka palola ma hope o ka ‘ae i ka ho‘opa‘ahao ‘ia ana, hiki i ia kanaka ke kāinoia a koho pāloka ma ka wā ho‘omalu a palola paha.

### NĀNAU PINEPINE - Ke Koho Pāloka Kahi ‘Ē
