- Manu o ku (white tern) – The manu o ku is the official bird of the City and County of Honolulu. It is common in the northwestern Hawaiian Islands. On the main Hawaiian Islands, they occur only on Oahu, and only in Honolulu.
- North Star – The North Star is a landmark, or sky marker, that helps those who follow it determine direction as it glows brightly to guide and lead toward a purposeful destination.
- Compass – A compass always points North, a direction which symbolizes progress, betterment, and inspiration. As a symbol, it signifies bringing motivation to a person feeling lost. It is also a symbol of guidance, safety, and security. It also means to step together or journey together.
- Finally, the color blue represents trust, calm, and responsibility.
