The Centre researches and documents Yukon Native Languages, trains Native Language Instructors for the schools, and produces curriculum and resource materials.

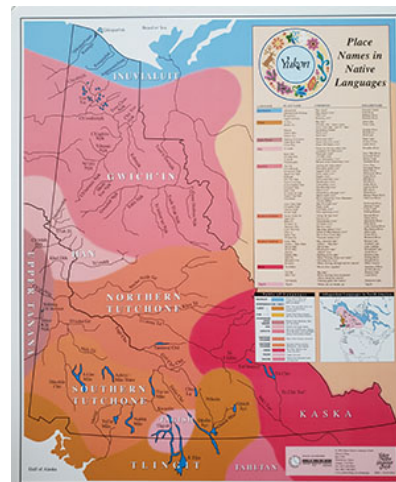
