

Mary Jane Kunnizzi

Mary Jane Kunnizzi was a fluent speaker of the Peel River Dialect of the Gwich'in language. The daughter of Andrew and Elizabeth Kunnizzi, Mary Jane was born and raised in Fort McPherson NWT. She attended a "day school" in Fort McPherson but her parents always took their children out of school in the winter to go trapping and hunting, and in the spring for the spring hunt.

In the late 1950s Mary Jane attended vocational school in Yellowknife for a couple of years. She worked for many years as a cook for construction companies and the local hostel. Mary Jane attended the Key-wee-tin Bible College in Lac La Biche, Alberta from 1990-93. She moved to the Yukon in 1993 and joined the Yukon Native Language Centre in September 1994.

Until her retirement from the Centre in May 2004, Mary Jane was Gwich'in translator and audiotape archivist. She worked on the Centre's extensive collection of tapes in Gwich'in, translating the legends and stories into English, duplicating tapes and sending copies to Yukon Archives. Mary Jane also summarized weekly recordings of the program *People Speak Gwich'in* from CBC in Inuvik, NWT.

She passed away in September 2012 and is greatly missed. YNLC is pleased to honour her memory by reprinting her book of Gwich'in language lessons.
