

Roulette

Roulette is a fascinating game that provides exciting action with its spinning wheel and bouncing white ball. By studying the adjacent chart you will see that Roulette offers a variety of bets – straight up on one number, combination of numbers, Red or Black and Odd or Even.

You play with your own distinct colored chips that are good only at the table where they were issued, the value of which is established at the time of your "buy-in." You also may play with value chips such as our \$1, \$5, or \$25 chips.

Each betting cycle begins with the Dealer spinning a small white ball in the opposite direction of the turning roulette wheel. Bets may be placed until the Dealer announces, "no more bets." When the ball comes to rest, the Dealer points out the winning number, and winning bets are paid. The exact placement of the chips determines the bet being made. Each player is responsible for the correct positioning of his/her wager on the layout regardless of whether the bet is placed by the Dealer.

Roulette Straight Bets		
Example Position	Odds	Description
A. Straight Up	35 to 1	All numbers, zero and double zero
B. Column Bet	2 to 1	Any of the 12 numbers in the column bet
C. Dozen	2 to 1	1 through 12, 13 through 24 or 25 through 36
D. Red or Black	1 to 1	The color on the number corresponds to color bet
E. Odd or Even	1 to 1	All odd numbers or all even numbers
F. 1 to 18 or 19 to 36	1 to 1	All numbers 1 through 18 or 19 through 36

Roulette Combination Bets			
Example Position	Odds	Description	
G. Split	17 to 1	Either of the two numbers split	
H. Row	11 to 1	Any of the three numbers in a row bet	
I. Corner	8 to 1	Any of the four numbers forming the corner	
J. Five Numbers	6 to 1	0, 00, 1, 2 or 3	
K. Six Numbers	5 to 1	Any of the six numbers in the two rows bet
